

**Little Prairie Primary**  
**2023-2024 Alternate Accountability Information**

ELA:

At least 80% of Kindergarten and 1st graders will score above the 25th percentile in the area of word segmenting (which aligns well to the shifts to the Science of Reading) according to the FastBridge Assessment, and at least 80% 2<sup>nd</sup> graders will show a year or more of growth in the area of reading according to our Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark results.

Our progress was measured using the Fast Bridge Assessment Suite and the Fountas and Pinnell Benchmark system.

According to our FastBridge data 85% of 5K students and 91% of first graders scored above the 25th percentile in the skill area of word segmenting, and according to our Foutas and Pinnell data 91% of second graders experienced a year or more of growth in reading.

Math:

At least 80% of 5K, 1st and 2nd grade students will score at/above the 25th percentile in math according to the spring grade level FAST Math assessments (early math subtests for 5K and 1st grade and math fluency in 2nd grade).

We measured progress toward this goal using the FAST Early Math Composite scores (5K and 1st grade) and FAST CBMmath Automaticity (2nd grade), which students took in the fall, winter, and spring.

We nearly met this goal in that 81% of 5K students, 72% of 1st grade students, and 81% of 2nd grade students scored in the 25th percentile or above, so overall 78% of students 5K-2nd Grade were above the 25th percentile according to their grade level FAST measure.

Attendance:

Our goal each year is to have a 95% attendance rate for students 5K-2nd grade. The last few years, we have been trying to ensure families understand the importance of school attendance which has been a bit challenging since COVID. This year, our overall attendance rate, according to our Skyward records, was 94%.

We measured progress toward this goal through tracking student attendance in our data management system.
